- 4. Please cut off the "Entry Form" at the cut-off line and paste it on the back side of the work. Make sure that it does not peel off from the work.

Please note that we will not accept any entries that are not accompanied by an application form. Submit one application form per work, even if you are applying as a group.

In the case of group entries from schools or art classes, it is acceptable to fill in the address, telephone number, and fax information for the school or class. In this case, please enter the name of the teacher in charge in the remarks column. In the case of group entries, please try to match the order of the entries with the order of the application form.
